# September 7th 2019

So what's so special about September the 7th?

Well it's 90 years since the formation of the Maidstone Model Engineering Society and as part of the celebrations they are hosting the 2019 Southern Federation Rally on this date.

The club consists of a 1826ft long, aluminium raised level track in 3.5" and 5" gauges complete with the usual facilities, as well as an area for traction engines, etc, all to be found in the extensive area of Mote Park in Maidstone.

As always, a current boiler certificate will be required for all steam engines wishing to run.

The track can be a demanding drive, with a climb starting around the first bend with varying grades, the climb stopping at the exit of the far end loop and then commencing the drop back to the station.

Various videos can be found by searching for Mote Park Railway or Maidstone MES on youTube.

Unfortunately there is no onsite camping this year but the club can provide a list of local accommodation if required. Food will be provided for visitors on Saturday lunchtime and fish & chips will be sent out for during the evening, when running will continue, but these will have to be ordered in advance,.


On Sunday visitors will still be welcome but note that from 2.30 the club will be passenger hauling for the public and if visitors wish to participate in this their locos must have spark arrestors.

Visitors staying locally are welcome to "pop in" on the Friday night when the club will be preparing the site.

The entrance for visitors with locos can be found at ME15 8JW, but if you're spectating it is requested that you use the public car park at ME15 7SX.
